

Assembly Member Anthony Adams Recall Failure Notice

Under Elections Code section 9031(a), if the statistical sampling shows that the projected number of valid signatures is within 95 to 110 percent of the number of signatures needed to qualify the recall for the ballot, Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties would then be required to examine and verify every signature (a process known as a "full check").

Under Elections Code section 9030(f), if the number of projected valid signatures is less than 95 percent of the number needed to qualify the recall for the ballot, the recall effort shall be deemed to have failed.

For this recall effort, 35,825 valid petition signatures were required to qualify the recall for the ballot. The number of projected valid signatures equaling 95 percent is 34,034. The number of projected valid signatures reported by Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties is 24,579. Therefore, this recall effort has failed.
